Beanie Pattern

Seafarers always appreciate your kind donations of hand-knitted beanies.

Each beanie is a symbol of friendship and helps to keep them warm

while they brave the elements at sea.

You will need:

Double knit or 4 ply wool. Size 8 (4mm) Needles. 2 oz of wool.

Cast on 120 stitches.

Rib (2 plain 2 purl) for 12 inches

Next Row: Knit 2 together to end of the row Purl next row.

Repeat these two rows once more.

Knit 1 row.

Purl 1 row.

Pull thread through all stitches and sew up seam.
